### What does God say about homosexuality?

The Bible is very clear about homosexuality being against God's will -- something we should not practice.

In the Old Testament God says it very clearly and plainly:

Leviticus 18:22 "Do not practice homosexuality; it is a detestable sin." (NLT - Old Testament)

The New Testament clearly reaffirms that homosexuality is a sin that keeps us separated from God and salvation.

1 Corinthians 6:9-10 "Don't you know that those who do wrong will have no share in the Kingdom of God? Don't fool yourselves. Those who indulge in sexual sin, who are idol worshippers, adulterers, male prostitutes, homosexuals, thieves, greedy people, drunkards, abusers, and swindlers - none of these will have a share in the Kingdom of God." (NLT - New Testament)

God has given us the free will to determine how we will live our lives. If we chose to turn our backs on God, God's response is to let us do whatever we want--and suffer the consequences.

Romans 1:21-27 "Yes, they knew God, but they wouldn't worship him as God or even give him thanks. And they began to think up foolish ideas of what God was like. The result was that their minds became dark and confused. Claiming to be wise, they became utter fools instead. And

instead of worshiping the glorious, ever-living God, they worshiped idols made to look like mere people, or birds or animals and snakes."

"So God let them go ahead and do whatever shameful things their hearts desired. As a result, they did vile and degrading things with each other's bodies. Instead of believing what they knew was the truth about God, they deliberately chose to believe lies. So they worshiped the things God made but not the creator himself, who is to be praised forever. Amen."
